Airbus Foundation and Aviation Sans Frontières Provide Relief Goods To The Philippines-cbr />- Aid Includes Medical Supplies, Clothing and Teddy Bears for Children<br />- Transported On Delivery Flight of Cebu Airs Latest A330-300<br />The Airbus Corporate Foundation and Aviation Sans Frontières have transported clothing and medical supplies to Manila from Toulouse aboard the delivery flight of Cebu Airs latest A330-300 aircraft.<br/> />The aircraft departed Toulouse on 10 March and arrived in the Philippine capital on 11 March loaded with 2.4 tonnes of goods collected by Aviation Sans Frontières and destined for World Vision, the international non-governmental organisation and its Development Foundation. <br />The donations include new clothes and shoes for children and babies, teddy bears, pens and schoolbooks, as well as blankets and medical supplies such as masks, gloves, disinfectant wipes and surgical hoods. These will be forwarded to communities affected by severe flooding and typhoons in the Philippines.<br/> Aviation sans Frontières has been a regular partner of the Airbus Foundation since 2008 for flights from Toulouse. This non-governmental organisation supports Airbus humanitarian ferry flights from France to countries in need or which have been affected by natural disasters. <br/>
