I benefited from the insight into the German mentality and their numerous activities in the industrial sector. I am hoping to gain a foothold on the European market with the robot I presented here as early as next year."

Emphasizing the spirit of the 2016 Accelerate@HHL Entrepreneurship Conference, the Chinese start-up founder commented, "Thanks to the international event at HHL, one thing became quite clear - only a strong team can facilitate business ideas to break through. Against this background, it would be desirable to recruit even more international employees for our start-ups in China and intensify our contacts with foreign universities such as HHL in the future."
