In his first visit to Bulgaria Mr. Heemskerk met with President of Bulgaria Rosen Plevneliev, Deputy Prime Minister for Economic Development Daniela Bobeva, Minister of Finance Petar Chobanov, Minister of labor and social policy Hasan Ademov, and Governor of Bulgarian National Bank Ivan Iskrov.-br />"It is very encouraging to see our strong partnership in the last 20+ years. The World Bank Group Country Partnership Strategy for Bulgaria, in place since 2011, has reinforced the move toward a knowledge partnership. This strategy is in support of smart, sustainable, and inclusive growth, and in line with the Europe 2020 agenda and National Reform Program. The World Banks knowledge and advisory services support Bulgaria to use EU funds more effectively.
